TASTING NOTES:

Complex nose of ripe yellow fruits and fresh herbs – lemon, grapefruit, green mango and fresh curry leaf are complimented by delicate green ginger and brioche notes.

Supple, fresh palate - medium in weight, lightly textural with a fresh, delicately stoney finish. Flavours range through dried pear, fresh curd, preserved lemon and almond.

VINTAGE SUMMARY:

With relatively good rainfall in Autumn, and again towards the end of Spring, soil moisture was generally at good levels going into Summer. This, along with reasonably cool summer temperatures, meant the vines were healthy; a good number of bunches set, and berry size remained at optimum levels for high quality wine grape growing.
