Flaxman Valley, Eden Valley

TASTING NOTES:

Deeply complex and dark brooding nose - dried currant, prune and Chinese plum fruit are laced with woody spice and complex dried herb elements, all underlain with notes of loam, umami, licorice and tar.

Classic Barossa Shiraz palate, dark fruits drenched in fine, velvety tannin. Full yet restrained , creamy dark fruits – blackberry, prune and plum flow over the palate to a long, fine tannin finish.

VINTAGE SUMMARY:

Fairly moderate winter and spring conditions facilitated robust vine growth. Ideal conditions in late spring/early summer led to successful fruit-set. Despite a warm and dry late December, old-vine vineyards coped well, ensuring healthy canopies with very little disease pressure. March and April brought essential light and warmth, combining with cool nights to result in full maturity across all grape varieties in the Eden Valley.
